Subject: Discuss Community Satisfaction Survey Questions

### **BACKGROUND**

Over the past ten years the city has conducted a biennial "Community Satisfaction Survey" with the National Research Center (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA) as part of the "National Citizen Survey" program. The 2017-2018 budget includes funding for the survey to be conducted this fall, with survey results available after the first of the year.

The city has conducted the survey in 2007, 2009, 2011 and 2013, and NRC will compare these past results with the 2017 survey. In addition, NRC will compare the results in Mountlake Terrace with those of over 500 other jurisdictions surveyed by NRC.

The purpose of a community survey is to identify what the city is doing well and where we can improve. In the short-term, the results of the survey can be used for planning, resource allocation, performance measurement and program/policy evaluation. In the long-term, this information helps us improve in our services, encourage civic engagement, pursue better quality of life for the community, and develop stronger community trust. Past surveys have covered the following topics:



### **ANALYSIS**

The city can include up to three additional questions as part of the 2017 survey. In the past, these questions have included topics of the civic campus project and economic development. Because the survey results will be available <u>after</u> the November vote on the civic campus project, I recommend that the 2017 survey focus the additional questions on the Council's goal of economic development. For example:

- Economic Development refers to the process of improving the quality of life for a community by creating and/or retaining jobs, services and supporting or growing incomes and the tax base. What should be the City's number one Economic Development priority?
  - o Encourage businesses to relocate and/or expand their business within the City limits
  - o Encourage more jobs
  - Help existing businesses
  - o Improve infrastructure
  - o Improve the City's image
  - o Increase the tax base for City services
- When it comes to Economic Development, I think the City has taken a proactive approach.
