City Council Sets Special Meeting to Discuss Future Direction

MOUNTLAKE TERRACE—The Mountlake Terrace City Council will hold a special work session/retreat on Saturday, March 3 to establish its goals and objectives for 2013-2014 and reaffirm key policy objectives for 2012. The special meeting will be held at the Interim City Hall, 6100 219th Street SW, Suite 220.

Currently, the 2010-2012 Council goals are:

- Protect and Enhance the City's Financial Health and Stability
- Generate Economic Development throughout the Community
- Review and prioritize Capital Infrastructure Needs and Implement Projects
- Develop and Implement a strategy to address the City's aging public facilities
- Develop and Implement more effective Communication and Outreach with the Community
- Maintain appropriate and essential Public Services in a cost effective manner.

The Council goals serve as the foundation of the city's biennial budget and work plan.
