Council to Decide on Renewing Medical Cannabis Moratorium

MOUNTLAKE TERRACE — A public hearing on renewal of the medical cannabis moratorium will be held by the City Council on February 6 at 7:00 pm, in the Interim City Hall, 6100 219th Street SW, 2nd floor.

The Council adopted a six-month moratorium at its April 4, 2011 meeting as a precaution while the Washington State Legislature was considering a bill to allow medical cannabis dispensaries and other activities. Changes to state law on medical cannabis (marijuana) were passed soon after this to allow certain types of medical cannabis collective gardens.

The moratorium was renewed by the City Council in September. During the City's moratorium, collective gardens for medical cannabis are not allowed in Mountlake Terrace. Whether or how they can be located later is an issue for more analysis and public input before a decision is made.

The moratorium allows the city additional time to review the issues and impacts of medical cannabis collective gardens and to propose options for addressing security, safety, taxation, property values, community risks and benefits, licensing, zoning, and other issues related to medical cannabis.
