NEW BUSINESS

School Safety Presentation

The Board would like to conduct a presentation on school safety. They would like to put together a packet for parents and do a survey regarding their concerns. The presentation will focus on cyber-bullying, harassment and texting/sexting.

Chief's Report

Assistant Chief Pete Caw advised that the overall trend has been a decrease in crime for the first quarter in 2010 and has started picking up for the second quarter. Filings in District Court have increased due to increased traffic enforcement. Officers are encouraged to have a increased presence in the community. Electronic home monitoring revenues were down for the first quarter, which is a direct reflection of the downturn in the economy.

Entry level testing for police candidates will take place on July 10, 2010 and interviews for lateral candidates will be held in the next two weeks.
