

2009 CALL TO ARTISTS

CATEGORIES

Paintings, Prints, Drawings, and Calligraphy:

Paintings: Oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, tempera, airbrush, gouache, encaustic, batik, fresco, collage and mixed media with painting dominant.

Prints: Relief, intaglio, mezzotint, lithograph, serigraph, monoprint, colograph and mixed media with print making dominant.

Drawings: Graphite, colored pencil, silverpoint, chalk, crayon, pen & ink, conté and mixed media with drawing dominant.

Calligraphy: Any medium or combination.

Photography: Film, digital or altered images originating from a film or digital camera.

Miniatures: Same media specifications as paintings, prints and drawings.

3-Dimensional: Nonfunctional three-dimensional art of any material.

GUIDELINES

- Artists of all ages are welcome.
- Artists may enter up to three pieces of art in each category and four in miniatures.
- There is a \$10 nonrefundable fee for each piece of artwork entered or \$10 for up to four miniatures.
- All entries must be for sale.
- 20% commission will be collected on all sales.
- All works must be original, created by the artist in the past two years and must not have been shown at a previous Arts of the Terrace show.
- No copies, derivatives or reproductions; work cannot be based on copyrighted or previously published materials.
- Artists may not substitute or alter the work after it has been accepted.
- Digital images of accepted work will be retained by the Arts of the Terrace. We may reproduce accepted artwork for promotional purposes.
- All entries will be juried from digital images. Awards will be selected from the original works of art.

IMAGE SPECIFICATIONS

Digital images are required. All entries must be submitted digitally on a CD via mail or enter on-line with jpeg. **Slides will not be accepted.**

- Provide one image for each piece submitted. Two images will be accepted for three-dimensional works.

Image Dimensions:

- 1024 pixels horizontal maximum
768 pixels vertical maximum

File Formats:

- Jpeg or tiff.

Photo Tips:

- Always shoot at the full size and highest quality image the camera is capable of.
- At least three megapixels. Five to eight megapixels are best.
- When working with a digital image, never work directly with a Jpeg file because every time a Jpeg is resaved it loses quality. Save as Jpeg on last step.
- DPI is only needed for printing.

FRAMING & SIZE REQUIREMENTS

Drawings, Paintings, Photography, Prints and Calligraphy:

- Finished work must not exceed 44" in height and 54" in length.
- Gallery-wrap canvas must have edges finished (painted).
- Wet paintings or damaged frames will not be accepted.

Miniatures:

- Painting size is 25 sq. inches. Maximum outside frame measurement must not exceed 48 sq. inches.
- Example: Image size 5" x 5" and frame size 8" x 6".
- Image must not appear to be part of a larger painting.

- Package artwork so that it may be returned to you. We will not return works without packaging and return postage.

3-Dimensional:

- Hand carrying size.
- Items deemed too fragile will not be accepted.
- No on-site assembly is allowed.
- Copies of other works, class work and commercially prepared kits will not be accepted.
