On-premise directional sign (Pursuant to MTMC 19.135.060.G)

Permit type: Building permit required
 Fee: Cost of permit based on value of sign
 Process: Administrative review and approval
 Type of sign: Permanent (mounted in ground or on building)
 Location: On site of business
 Size: 6 square feet, maximum
 Text: See "Definition," on other panel

Off-premise directional sign (Pursuant to MTMC 19.135.100.A)

Permit types: Special Use Sign Permit and Building permit
 Fee, special use: Refer to current fee schedule
 Fee, building permit: Cost of permit based on value of sign
 Process: Administrative review and approval
 Type of sign: Permanent (mounted in ground or on building)
 Location: On private property
 Size: 24 square feet maximum; 20 feet maximum height (for a free-standing/monument sign)
 Text: See "Definition," on next panel

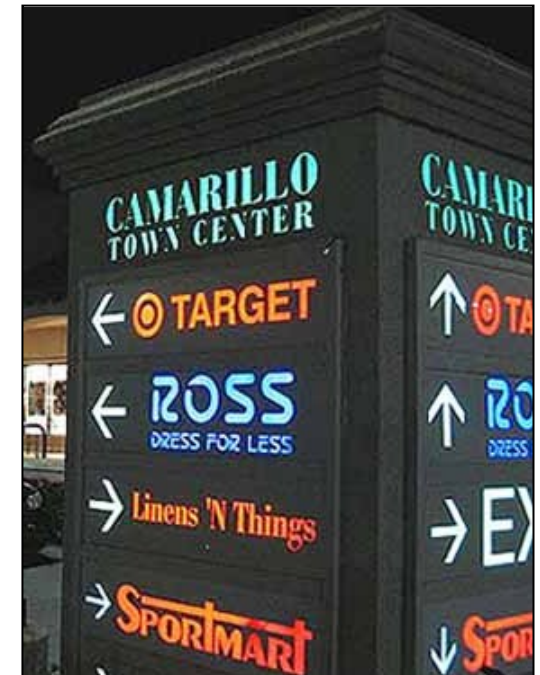


Definition (Pursuant to MTMC 19.135.020)

“Sign, directional” means a sign which identifies a business, or service, or product located within or without the City limits and provides direction thereto through written description, address, and/or graphic or pictorial illustration.

Special note

Traffic signs, directional signs, and signs displaying a public service message installed by a governmental agency are allowed, consistent with traffic safety requirements.
