



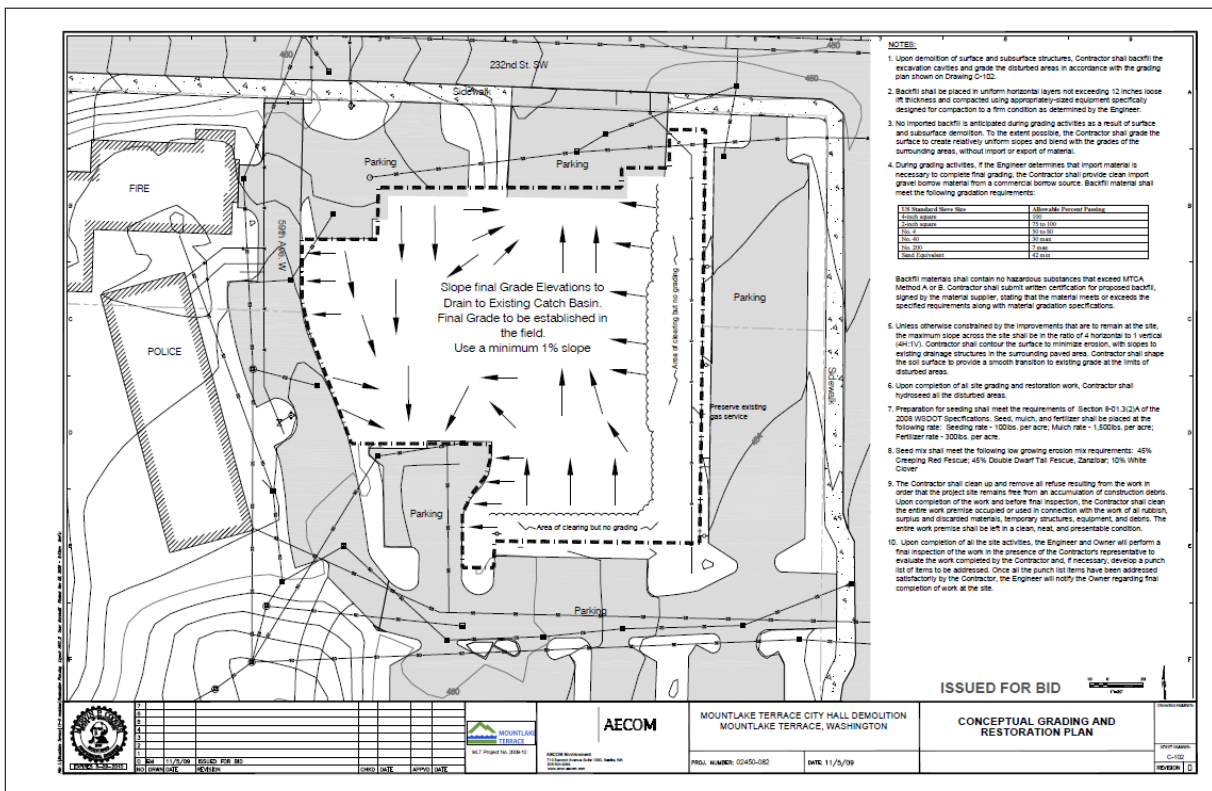
RFQ for Professional Architectural and Engineering Design Services for Construction of a New City Hall and Police Station Expansion

Responses to RFQ Questions Updated January 19, 2018

1. Has the geotechnical work already been completed for the projects in this posting?
The existing Police Station and Mountlake Terrace Library buildings are on top of pilings. The existing Police Station was built in the early 1990s and needs to be upgraded, per international UBC on seismic.
