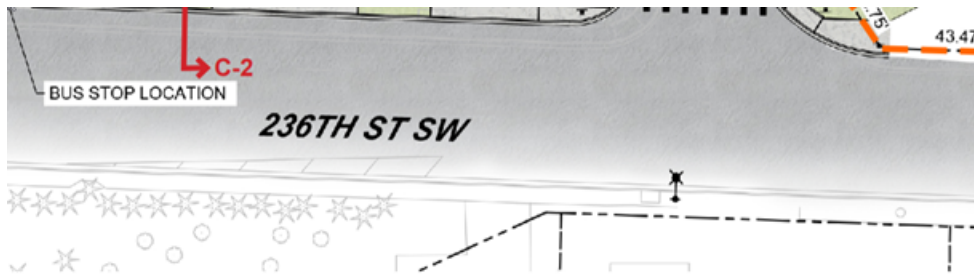
As far as we know, the ST is going to surplus the property according to their policies and state law (e.g., sold to the private sector, or turned over to an agency involved in affordable housing).
