

Utility Rate Updates for 2024

Water rates will remain the same Jan. 1.

The City Council is preparing to update the Water System Comprehensive Plan and Rate Study. Customers should expect previously scheduled increases for sewer and stormwater (see charts below).

The water, sewer and stormwater utilities will have their rates re-evaluated in alignment with the city’s major [Comprehensive Plan Update – Vision 2044](#), which adjusts growth targets and evaluates zoning. The number of people who will live and work here, and the concentration of that new density, has a direct impact on how the city provides utility services.

New and updated infrastructure is needed, and those expenditures have to be balanced over the years and can affect future rates.

In the meantime, current water rates will carry into 2024. The highest priority of the Public Works Department is to provide safe drinking water. Taking this time now to evaluate current and future infrastructure needs will ensure that we continue to meet the health and safety needs of the community.
